

Free Saturday travel for Victorian seniors and upcoming myki mailout

From September 2010, all Victorian seniors who are registered Sunday Pass holders will begin to receive their free registered myki in the post. More than 400,000 cards will be sent out to Victorian seniors and this is expected to take about 10 weeks to complete.

The Victorian Government has also announced seniors will get free travel in two consecutive zones on Saturdays from 1 January 2011 as well as Sundays.

- Eligible Victorian seniors will get free travel in two consecutive zones on Saturdays (from 1 January 2011) and Sundays.
- All seniors who apply will have their first myki issued free of charge.
- If you are already registered for the Sunday Pass you will receive a free myki in the post.
- If you don't have a Sunday Pass and are eligible, you can apply now at myki.com.au, premium train stations, staffed V/Line stations and the MetShop.
- We will start sending myki cards to seniors in the mail from September 2010.

myki travel tips for seniors

- You must carry your Victorian Seniors Card with you when travelling with myki as this is proof of your concession entitlement.
- Remember to keep your myki topped up with either myki money or myki pass so you're ready for travel at all times.
- Keep a positive balance on your myki at all times, even for free travel days.

You can currently top up your myki:

- at myki machines at metropolitan train stations and selected tram platform stops or bus interchanges
- over the phone on 13 6954 (13 myki)
- online at myki.com.au
- on board regional town bus services.

Over time, you will be able to top up your myki at more locations.

Seniors will be supported as they transition to myki via a public education campaign and a number of customer support channels.

As you're a Sunday Pass holder we're sending you a free Seniors myki. Your myki allows you to access senior concession fares and includes your Sunday Pass.

From 1 January 2011 your Seniors myki will also let you travel free on Saturdays.

Your Metcard Sunday Pass will continue to be accepted until it is phased out in 2011.



Seniors myki and free weekend travel

From 1 January 2011 your free travel entitlement will include Saturdays and Sundays. So if you travel with myki within two adjacent zones on the weekend, it's free.

You can currently use your myki to travel on Melbourne's trains, trams and buses, and on regional town bus services in Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Seymour and Latrobe Valley.

In the future you will also be able to use myki on V/Line. We will let you know when.
